VARIETAL Pinot Noir

HARVEST Hand picked on Monday, April 1, 2019.

APPELLATION Vista Flores, Uco Valley, Mendoza.

VINEYARD

Vineyard in Vista Flores, approximately 50 years old, 1,000 MASL. Vine planted in 1957 in traditional rows with natural low yield. Continental, semi-arid climate.

Soil Sandy, deep, poor soil with low organic material.

VEGETATIVE CYCLE

It was a harvest with good yields as Mendoza did not suffer significant weather events that year.

The winter of 2018 was the coldest of the past four years. As a consequence, there was excellent bud break between late September and early October.

In terms of the harvest, we could say that it was similar to 2018 with regard to the good yields of the vines. However, the cool temperatures in March and April gave the grapes a significantly higher natural acidity than the previous year.

AGING

Aged in concrete eggs with fine lees for 11 months.

TASTING NOTES

Deep cherry red color with purplish tints. It is fresh and fruity on the nose, with the fragrance of red and black cherries and some spicy notes like country herbs and a touch of graphite from its time in concrete. It is a juicy, textured, friendly wine with a long finish.



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
